
RECONNECTING: New and improved co-op website makes its debut

With the roll out of the cooperative's new website we're also pleased to announce two new services.



1. **What form do I need to file for the federal credit?**

IRS Form 5695

2. **How do I know if a product qualifies for the tax credit?**

You should obtain a copy of the manufacturer's tax credit certification statement before finalizing your purchase. Most major manufacturers are posting the documentation on their websites

3. **Can the tax credit be carried over for future years?**

The tax credit for products at 30% up to \$1,500 CAN NOT be carried over to future years.

The tax credit for qualifying products at 30% with no upper limit CAN be carried forward to future years through 2016.


Tideland EMC's new website also features an online storm center. Major outage updates will be provided on this section of the website. You'll also find the following information in the storm center:

Storm Preparedness: An ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure. That's why we've provided an easy to follow guide to help you and your family prepare for a major weather event.


